SUPPLIES NEEDED

- **Medical supplies** (bandages, peroxide or other disinfectants, gauze, aspirin, latex gloves, masks)
- **Personal hygiene items** (diapers, wipes, deodorant, sunscreen, sanitary napkins, tampons, toothpaste, and toothbrushes)
- **Shelter items** (sleeping bags, tents, ponchos, blankets, flat sheets, umbrellas, candles, non-battery flashlights and radios)
- **Food** (non perishable goods and all non canned items such as rice, pasta, granola/energy bars, cereal, dried beans, and oatmeal.)

Supplies can be dropped off at the following locations:

- The home of Nadege Joseph – 128 Mt. Pleasant St. Anytime after 4pm

- Cape Verdean Vets Hall – 561 Purchase St.

Delivery of Supplies

- A rental truck will be driven down to South Miami, Florida next weekend and deliver the supplies that are collected at all the drop off points.
- At that point, the members of 1st and Alton Volunteer Team in Miami Beach will fly the supplies out to Haiti in their member's privately owned plane.
- 1st and Alton Volunteer Team have been doing dynamite work flying supplies out to Haiti everyday since the initial earthquake and are navigating logistics between the plane, trucks, and doctors to assure that the aid gets to the right place.
